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ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda.

H. E. Ms. Marie Charlotte G. Tang, Vice Chair, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Philippines the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), will open and chair the morning meeting. H. E. Mr. Anouar Ben Youssef Vice Chair, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Tunisia to UNEP, will chair the afternoon meeting. Delegations will be invited to adopt the provisional agenda.

2. Briefing on the work of the Climate Technology Centre and Network.¹

Pursuant to the CPR decision 171/2 of 16 September 2025, in which the Committee requested the Secretariat to provide a presentation on the work of the Climate Technology Centre and Network (CTCN) on capacity-building, technology and technology transfer, the Secretariat will provide an update on the work of the CTCN, including support provided through technical assistance, knowledge-sharing and capacity-building, as well as progress in implementing its 2023–2027 Programme of Work. The Committee will be invited to take note of the briefing and engage in an exchange of views.

3. Consideration of relevant evaluation reports and audits.¹

The Evaluation Office will present the recently concluded evaluation of the Nature Action Subprogramme, followed by a management response by the Secretariat (Ecosystems Division). The Committee will be invited to take note of the evaluation report, its management response and provide guidance as appropriate.

4. Briefing on the activities leading up to the fourth part of the fifth session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee on Plastic Pollution, including in the marine environment.

The Secretariat will provide a briefing on the activities leading up to the fourth part of the fifth session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee to develop an international legally binding instrument on plastic pollution, including in the marine environment (INC 5.4). The Committee is invited to take note of the briefing and engage in an exchange of views.

5. Briefing on the Global Youth Environment Assembly 2025.¹

The Secretariat will provide a briefing on the outcomes and follow-up of the Global Youth Environment Assembly (YEA) 2025, held at the UNEP headquarters in Nairobi and online on 29 and 30 November and 7 December 2025, in preparation for the seventh session of the United Nations Environment Assembly. With more than 1,000 in-person participants, YEA represented the largest youth mobilization in UNEA history and, in accordance with UNEA resolution 7/6, serves as the principal youth platform under UNEA. The Committee will be invited to take note of the presentation and engage in an exchange of views.

6. Other matters.

The meeting will consider any other matters related to its work.

7. Closing of the meeting.

The meeting is expected to close at 16:00 (GMT+3).
