The Environment Management Group (EMG)



- ❑ A UN system-wide coordination body on environment and human settlements.
- ❑ Established in 2001
- ❑ 52 UN entities members and 3 observing bodies.
- ❑ Identifies issues on the international environmental agenda that warrant UN system-wide collaboration.
