2. Introduction of UNEA-7 draft decisions and Q&A session.

In line with the proposed [roadmap of the intersessional period](#) endorsed by the Bureaux of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA) and the CPR at their joint meeting held on 3 July 2025, the Secretariat will introduce three draft decisions to be considered at the upcoming seventh session of UNEA, to be held from 8 to 12 December 2025, in the following order:

- Draft decision entitled “Management of trust funds and earmarked contributions”;
- Draft decision entitled “Provisional Agenda, dates and venue of the eighth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly”; and
- Draft decision entitled “Approval of the draft medium-term strategy for the period 2026-2029 and a draft programme of work and budget for the period 2026-2027”.

The introduction of each draft decision will be followed by a session of questions and answers with Member States, observers, and the Major Groups and Stakeholders. The draft decisions can be accessed through the [e-Proposals module](#).

The Secretariat will provide an update on the status of the preparation of the seventh edition of the Global Environment Outlook (GEO-7). The presentation will include: 1) an update on the preparation for the GEO-7 Summary for Policy Makers Review and Approval Meeting; and 2) an update on the GEO-7 launch, outreach and communication plan. The Committee will be invited to take note of the briefing and engage in an exchange of views with the Committee members and the Secretariat.
