

UNITED NATIONS SYSTEM ENTITIES

Representatives of Specialized Agencies (FAO, ICAO, IFAD, ILO, IMF, IMO, ITU, UNESCO, UNIDO, UNWTO, UPU, World Bank, WHO, WIPO and WMO) and related organizations (which include CTBTO Preparatory Commission, IAEA, ICC, IOM, ISA, OPCW and WTO), as well as from UN Secretariat, funds, programmes, regional commissions, Secretariat of the Multilateral Environmental Agreements administered by UNEP and other UN entities are required to register through the online registration system INDICO to participate as observers in the INC-2.

Each UN system entity will be able to register up to five (5) representatives through the online registration system INDICO to participate as observers. To access the registration for United Nations System Entities please click here: [UN System registration](#).

Each participant will be required to register individually, and an official email address should be used for registration.

Please be reminded that as part of the registration process, the following documentation will need to be uploaded to INDICO at the time of the registration:

1. Copy of the nomination letter containing the names and functional titles of the delegation (delegation list).
2. A passport-size colour photograph (with white, grey, or neutral colour background).
3. The passport bio page.

Please note that the review and verification process of online registrations may take up to 4-5 working days.

Registration through the online registration system INDICO is also required for all UN staff members who have been designated to support the INC-2 onsite. In this case a copy of the official delegation lists submitted by their offices must be uploaded.

Deadline for registration to participate in the INC-2 was 28 April 2023.

No more applications will be accepted at this stage. Additional information on registration in advance of INC-3 will be made available in due course.

There will be no on-site registration.
