2. First reading of UNEA-7 draft resolutions.

In line with the [roadmap of the intersessional period](#) endorsed by the Bureaux of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA) and the CPR at their joint meeting held on 3 July 2025, and following the introduction of the draft resolutions at the subcommittee meetings of the CPR held on 21 October 2025 and 24 October 2025, under the leadership of the co-facilitators appointed by the President of the Assembly and the Chair of the CPR, the Committee will undertake an in-depth paragraph-by-paragraph informal consultations beginning with the operative paragraphs of the draft resolutions to be considered at the upcoming seventh session of UNEA (UNEA-7).
