Chair's Summary

Agenda item 1: Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda.

1. H. E. Mr. Anouar Ben Youssef, Vice Chair of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR), Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Tunisia to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), opened and chaired the meeting.

Agenda item 2: First reading of draft resolutions to be considered by UNEA-7.

3. The co-facilitators invited delegations to an in-depth paragraph-by-paragraph informal consultations on the preambular paragraphs of the following draft resolutions to be considered at the upcoming [seventh session of the United Nations Environment Assembly](#) (UNEA-7), in the following order:
 - i. Draft resolution entitled “Strengthening global response on the management of fires”, submitted by India;
 - ii. Draft resolution entitled “Establishing a sectoral needs-assessment framework for the transition to a circular economy”, submitted by the Republic of Korea; and
 - iii. Draft resolution entitled “Environmental sustainability of Artificial Intelligence systems”, submitted by Kenya.
4. Delegations¹ offered comments and textual proposals on the three draft resolutions. Representatives of Major Groups and Stakeholders² also delivered general statements expressing their views on the drafts.
5. After the meeting, the updated versions of the draft resolutions, reflecting the inputs provided by delegations as captured on screen, have been made available through the e-Proposals module on [e-deleGATE](#). Additionally, the updated versions without attributions will be submitted for editing by the United Nations Office at Nairobi (UNON) for transmission to the Open-ended CPR.
