Chair's Summary

Agenda item 1: Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda.

1. H. E. Ms. Romy Tincopa, Vice Chair of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR), Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Peru to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), opened the meeting and chaired the morning session. H. E. Ms. Marie Charlotte Tang, Vice Chair of the CPR, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of the Philippines to UNEP, chaired the afternoon session.

Agenda item 2: First reading of draft resolutions to be considered by UNEA-7.

3. The co-facilitators invited delegations to an in-depth paragraph-by-paragraph informal consultations on the four draft resolutions to be considered at the upcoming seventh session of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA-7), in the following order:
 - i. Draft resolution entitled “Establishing a sectoral needs-assessment framework for the transition to a circular economy”, submitted by the Republic of Korea;
 - ii. Draft resolution entitled “Environmental dimensions of antimicrobial resistance”, submitted by Kenya;
 - iii. Draft resolution entitled “Promoting sustainable solutions through sport for a resilient planet”, submitted by Kenya; and
 - iv. Draft resolution entitled “Environmental sustainability of Artificial Intelligence systems”, submitted by Kenya.
4. Delegations offered comments and text proposals on the four draft resolutions. The updated versions of the draft resolutions, reflecting the inputs provided by delegations as captured on the screen, have been made available through the e-Proposals module on [e-deleGATE](#) platform after the meeting. Additionally, Major Groups and Stakeholders provided general statements expressing their views on the drafts.

Mr. Peter Maddens, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Belgium to UNEP, as co-facilitator of the informal consultations on the draft ministerial declaration of UNEA-7, informed of the upcoming consultations to be held on Thursday, 13 November, from 14:00 to 16:00 (GMT+3).
