Chair's Summary

1. H. E. Mr. Sultan Hajiyeve, Chair of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR), Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Azerbaijan to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), opened and chaired the meeting.

3. The Chair informed the Committee of the withdrawal of the draft resolution entitled “Recognizing the crime of ecocide to address environmental destruction and climate harm” submitted by Vanuatu.

 - i. Draft resolution entitled “Enhancing the meaningful participation of children and youth in environmental and climate change action”, submitted by Sri Lanka;
 - ii. Draft resolution entitled “Scaling up synergies in the implementation and mainstreaming of multilateral environmental agreements at national and local levels”, submitted by Japan;
 - iii. Draft resolution entitled “Safe, responsible and sustainable AI for people and planet”, submitted by Kenya;
 - iv. Draft resolution entitled “Promoting sustainable solutions through sports for a resilient planet”, submitted by Kenya;
 - v. Draft resolution entitled “Enhancing international environmental cooperation based on Needs Assessment for the transition to a circular economy”, submitted by the Republic of Korea;
 - vi. Draft resolution entitled “Environmental dimensions of antimicrobial resistance”, submitted by Kenya;
 - vii. Draft resolution entitled “Advancing options for international instruments on the environmentally sound management of minerals and metals”, submitted by Colombia.
5. The introduction of each draft resolution was followed by a Secretariat presentation of the technical note, along with questions and answers from the delegations¹, the proponents and the Secretariat.
