The Forum will be jointly organized by the Government of Fiji's Ministry of Environment and Climate Change and the United Nations Environment Programme under the Theme 'Advancing sustainable solutions for a resilient planet'.

The Forum Serves as instrumental platforms, fostering dialogue, cooperation, and actionable commitments towards the achievement of environmental goals at all levels and the implementation of UNEP's programme of work considering diverse geographical and political landscapes. The Forum is a platform for governments, intergovernmental organizations, UN organizations, and major groups and other stakeholders, to discuss the regional environmental priorities and provide regional inputs to the outcome of the 7th session of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA-7) scheduled to be held from 8 to 12 December 2025 in Nairobi.

The Forum is also an occasion for UNEP partners, UN organizations, private sector representatives, scientists, academia, and civil society to bring their perspectives and ideas to achieve the environmental dimension of the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda and Sustainable Development Goals
