Colleagues,

1. At the outset, our delegation wishes to associate ourselves with the statement delivered by Colombia on behalf of G77 and China, as well the statement delivered by Pakistan on behalf of Asia Pacific Group.
2. I wish to congratulate the Chair for his able leadership, and in this opportunity, I would also like to join him in welcoming new PRs and DPRs to Nairobi. Karibuni Kenya.
3. My delegation thanks the ED for her presentation of the Quarterly report for April – June 2022 and her remarks in this regard.

4. My delegation wishes to underscore the need to have equal treatment of all resolutions adopted at UNEA 5.2. We have seen several communications from the ED on some resolutions, but we haven't seen any communication on the other resolutions. Unfortunately, that includes resolution 5/4 on Sustainable Lake Management.
5. Member States need to have complete picture of the state-of-play, "where we are now" in the context of implementation of UNEA 5.2 resolutions, in its entirety.
6. In light of the above, we urge the Secretariat to speed up the implementation of the remaining resolutions, and to provide regular updates to Member States in this regard.

7. On the Quarterly Report, we take note the activities in the Asia Pacific region, mentioned in the Report. We would request that future quarterly report can be uploaded sooner in the portal to allow member states ample time to study and analyze the document thoroughly.
8. Finally, our delegation would like to raise the necessity for UNEP Secretariat to provide substantive briefings outside the existing governing bodies meeting, on works and mandates of each Divisions. We believe that it serves as an avenue to provide better understanding on the works and priorities of each Divisions, as well as related Resolutions which falls under their respective mandates.
