Sendai Framework & 2030 Agenda: Common Indicators



Origin and architecture of SFM

Event-based database (DesInventar, EM-DAT)

"an event" - getting precise data on impact of distinct disaster events

Place: Where the disaster took place?

Date: When the disaster took place?

Hazard: Which type of hazard triggered the disaster?

Impacts: Which where the human and economic impacts –direct losses

Aggregated database (SFM)

"getting the big picture" - Annual figures & understanding the trends

Geography/place - where are the losses/ impacts located

Hazard – what are annual losses associated with a distinct hazard

Impacts: the human and economic impacts over a period of a year

Sendai Framework Monitor (SFM) in a Nutshell

Measures Progress Against Sendai Targets

Helps countries to track progress against their DRR commitments.

An Official and Inclusive Process

Led by Governments the process promotes an inclusive approach.

Focal points are designated by **Note verbale**.

Contributes to SDG Reporting

SFM data are sent to UNDESA to report on indicators linked to DRR – SDG 1, 11 and 13.

Several layers of reporting

GLOBAL TARGETS



Common targets for all countries (Targets A to G).

- Agreed through the OIEWG
- Measure DRR progress by 2030
- Progress is documented in the biennial Global Assessment Reports (GAR).

NATIONAL / CUSTOM TARGETS



Possibility to **add national custom indicators**.

- Based on country priorities, usually from the national DRR strategy
- Will be reflected in the national DRR reports of the countries.

REGIONAL TARGETS



Reporting against **regional targets** from the Programme of Action for the implementation of the Sendai Framework in Africa (POA).

SFM timeline for reporting and milestones for 2024

31 March 2024

- Provision of **baseline data** for indicators under Targets A and B and optionally under Targets C and D for the period January 2005 to December 2014.
- Reporting of required data for indicators under Targets A, B, C, D and E for the period January 2015 to December 2023.

30 September 2024

- Data for all Targets A-G till December 2023.
