The Secretariat will present the feedback from the survey undertaken by the participants following the conclusion of the seventh session of the United Nations Environment Assembly as well as the preliminary findings of the Assembly's communications performance across media and digital channels. One of the co-facilitators of the UNEA-7 resolutions and decisions will present the summary of the discussion held during the CPR Bureau meeting on 19 February 2026. Delegations will have the opportunity to provide their assessment of the session.
