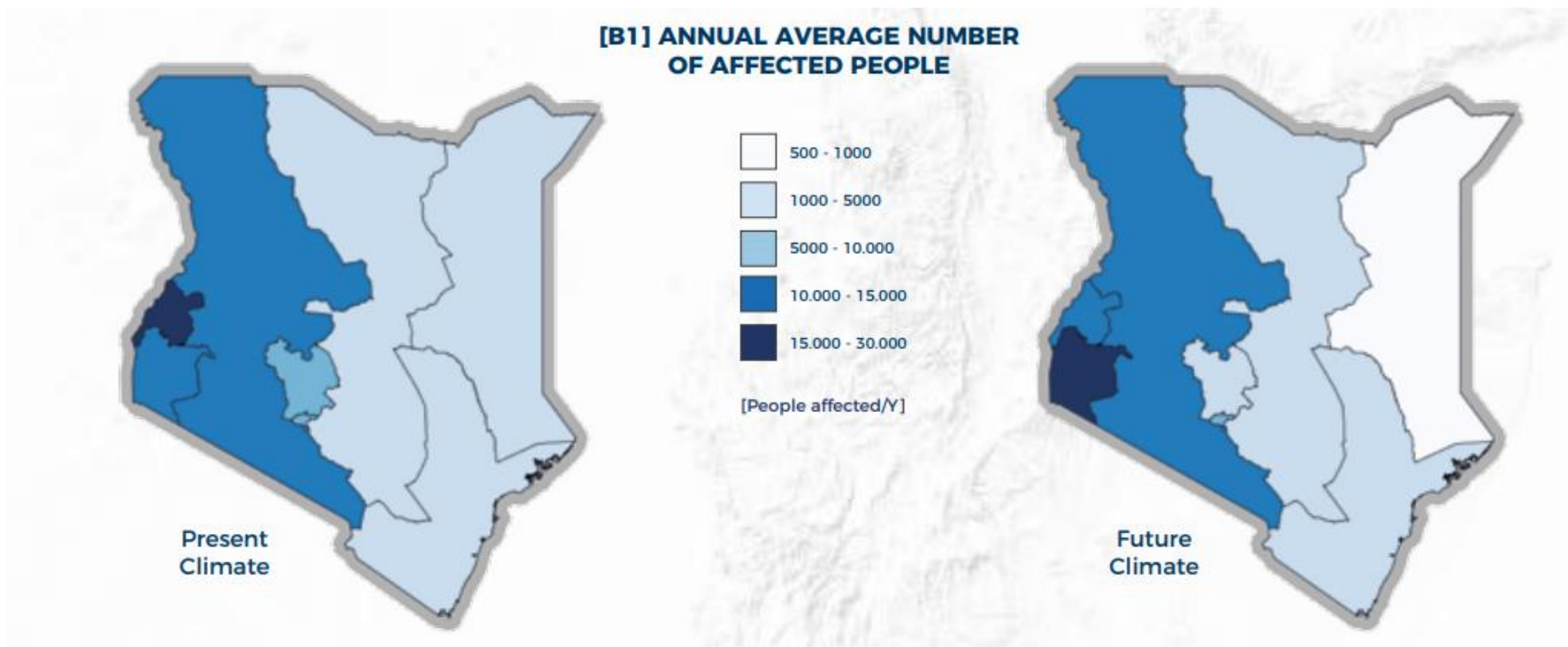

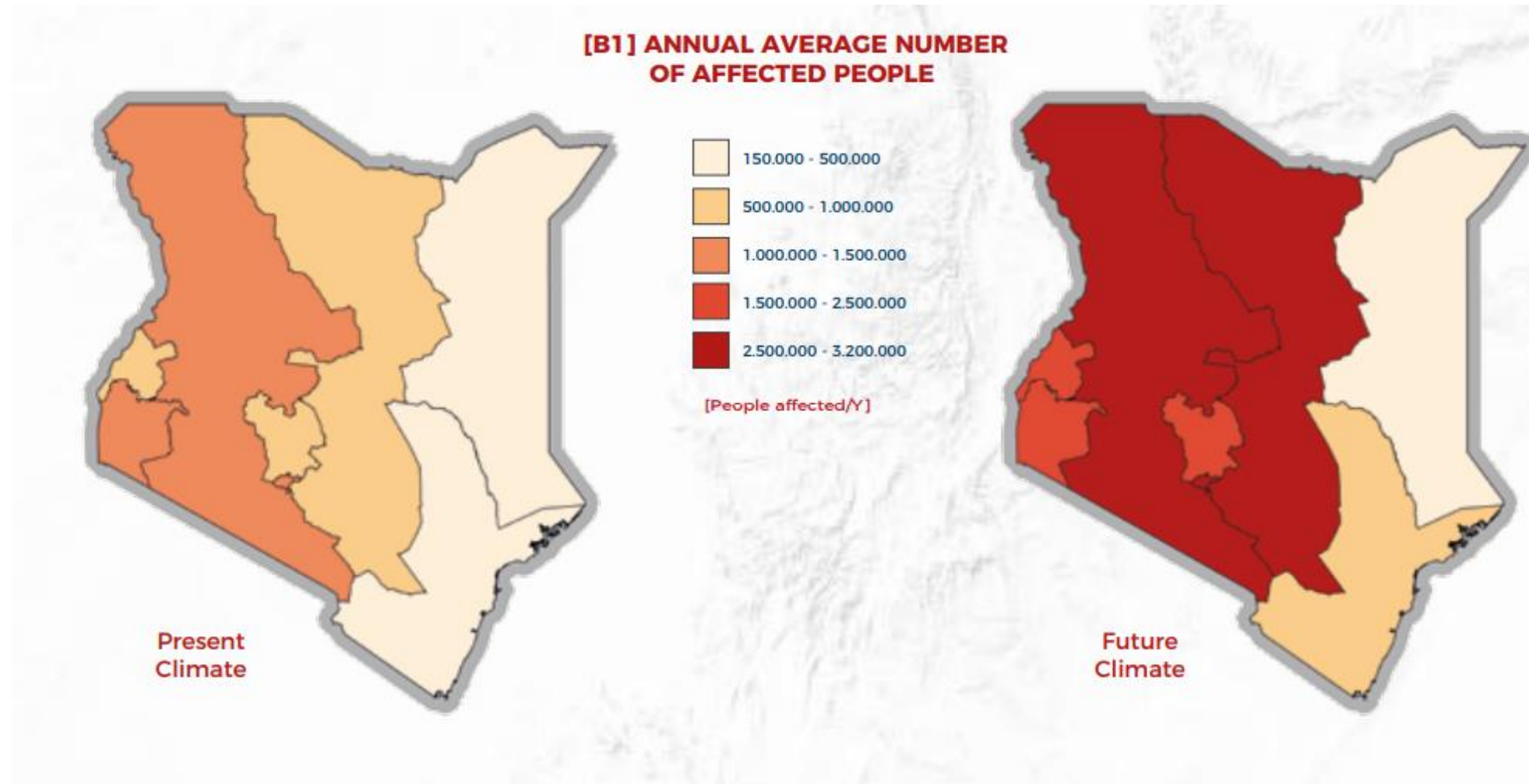

Support to strengthen the disaster data information management system

Phase 1: Comprehensive disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation budget tagging, tracking, and monitoring

- a. Desk Review of Annual Expenditures using the Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation Budget Tagging Guide for Design and Taxonomy, produced by UNDRR and the International Institute for Environment and Development
- b. Develop recommendations to operationalize the budget tagging with the Ministry of Finance
- c. Training and capacity building on the DCBT Methodology for government officials and accountability actors

Phase 2: Develop and Adopt a National Disaster Risk Reduction Financing Strategies

- a. Conduct a Diagnostic Study to identify cost-effective financing instruments for DRR and CCA, considering available resources and Kenya priorities.
- b. Develop a DRR financing roadmap to advocate vis-a vis the DRR stakeholders in Kenya to support the financing and implementation of the DRR National strategy and plans, based off the Diagnostic study.

DCBT Methodology

- **Main focus** is to influence the annual budget process and ensure the mainstreaming of DRR and CCA in decision-making
- **Quantifies the amount allocated to DRR and CCA** priorities and enables spending to be tracked over time
- **Identification of financing needs and gaps for DRR and CCA**

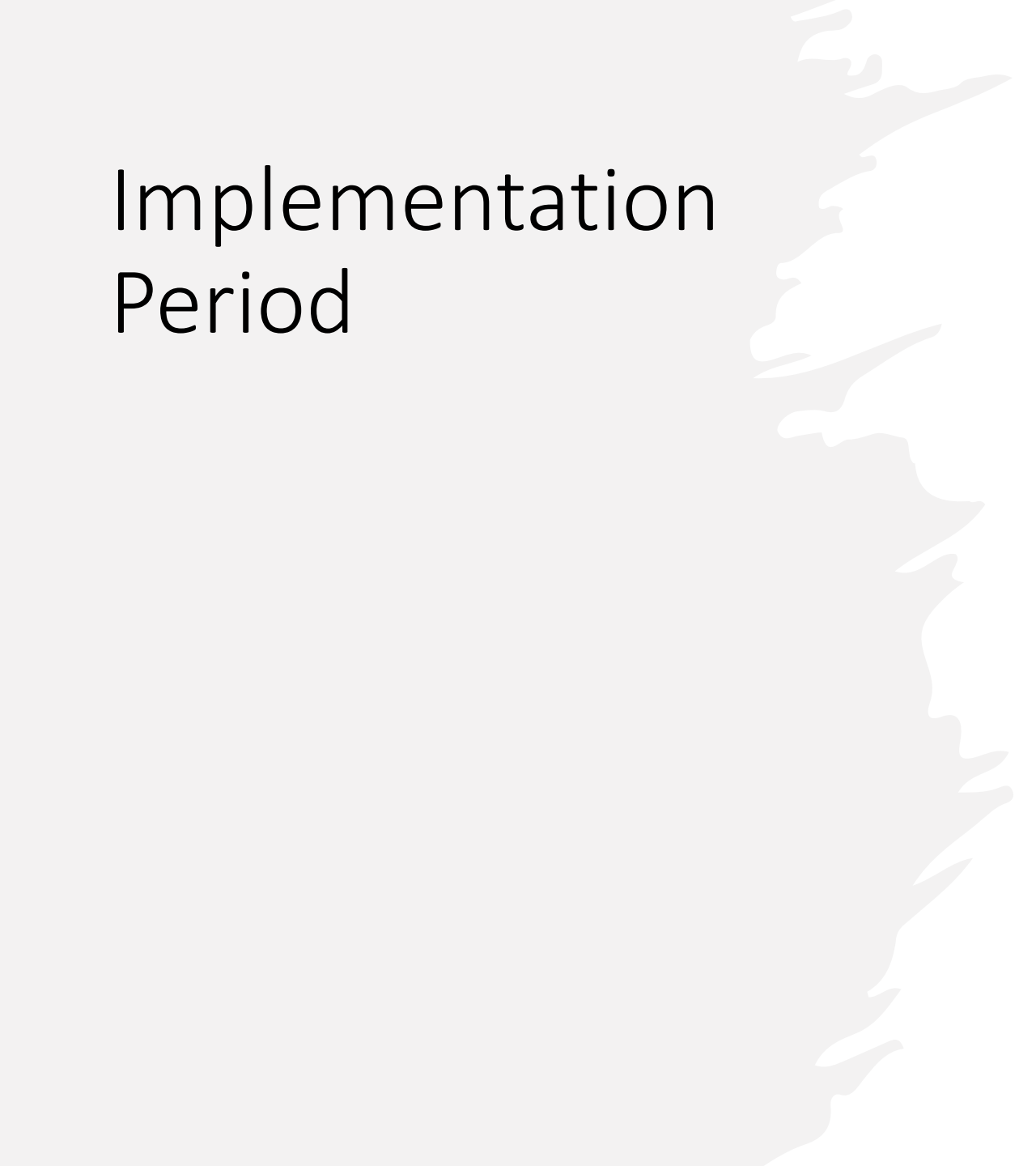


DCBT Methodology (2)

- **Methodological guide and taxonomy for DCBT**
 - Builds on the OECD DAC approach
 - Basic standard international approach, which is flexible and can be expanded to suit national circumstances
 - Presents the issues that need to be considered when designing a coordinated budget tagging initiative (DCBT) that addresses both DRR and CCA
