2. UNEA contribution to the High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development.

The Secretariat will brief on the preparations of the draft contribution of the United Nations Environment Assembly to the 2026 High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF), to be held under the auspices of the Economic and Social Council from 6 to 15 July 2026 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York under the theme “Transformative, equitable, innovative and coordinated actions for the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and its Sustainable Development Goals for a sustainable future for all”, followed by an exchange of views.

3. Assessment of the seventh session of the United Nations Environment Assembly.

The Secretariat will introduce an assessment of the seventh session of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA-7). The co-facilitators of the draft resolutions and decisions adopted at UNEA-7 will be invited to share their views on any lessons learned, followed by an exchange of views.

The Bureau will be invited to consider the organization of work of the Committee of Permanent Representatives based on an updated roadmap for the UN Environment Programme Governing Bodies for the period January to December 2026, which was considered by the Bureau on 7 October 2025.
