

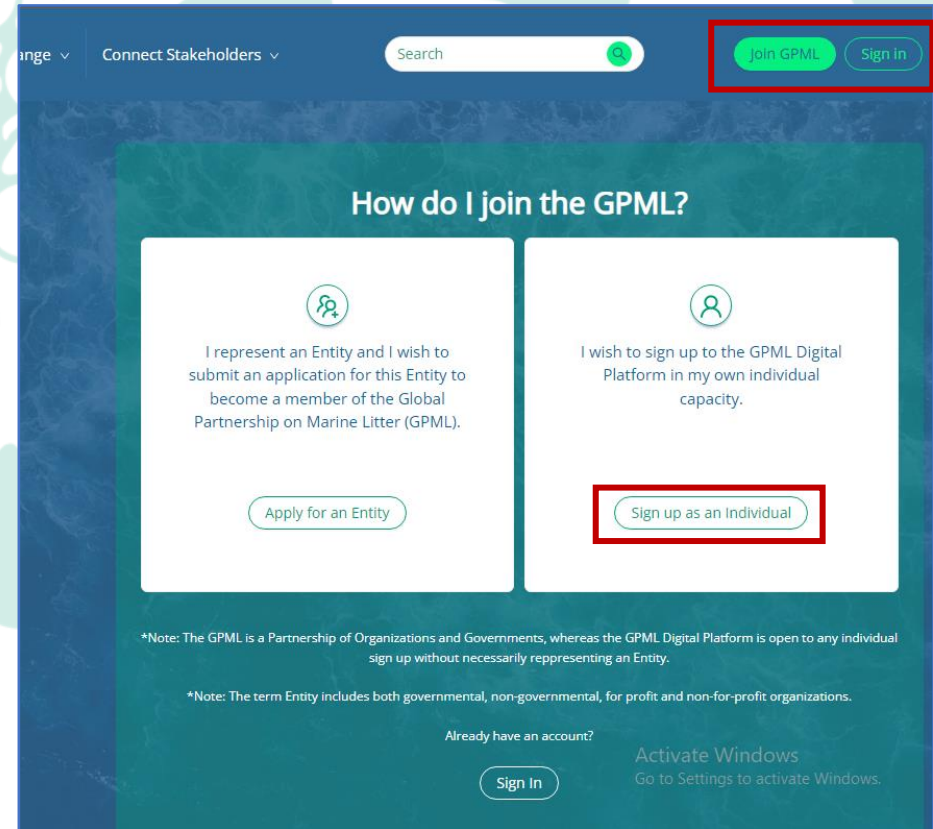
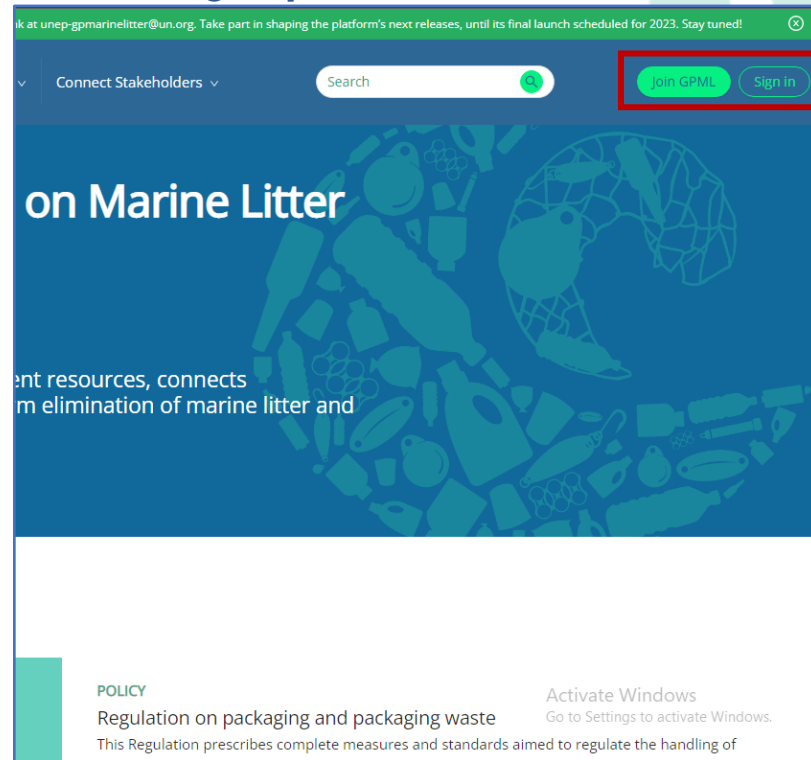

Accessing the GPML Digital Platform Communities of Practice Forums

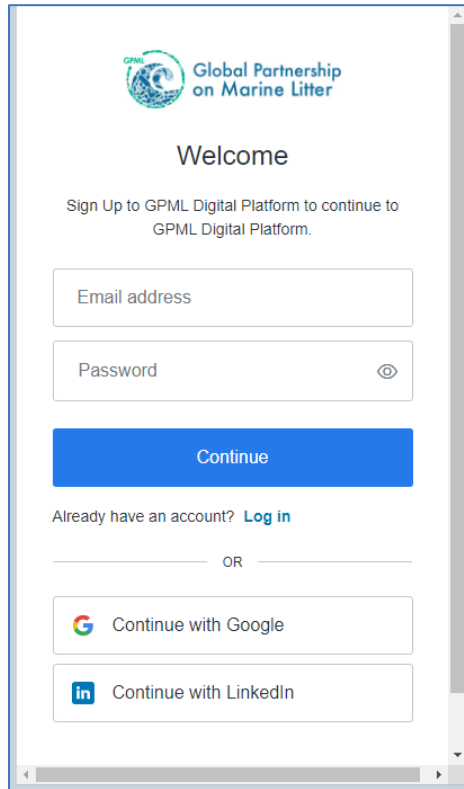

1. Open your preferred browser and navigate to <https://digital.gpmarinelitter.org/>.
2. On the top right, below the disclaimer
 - If you don't have an account, click on **Join GPML**. Go to step 3
 - If you have an account, click on **Sign In**. Skip step 3 & 4.
3. Click on **Sign up as an individual**.

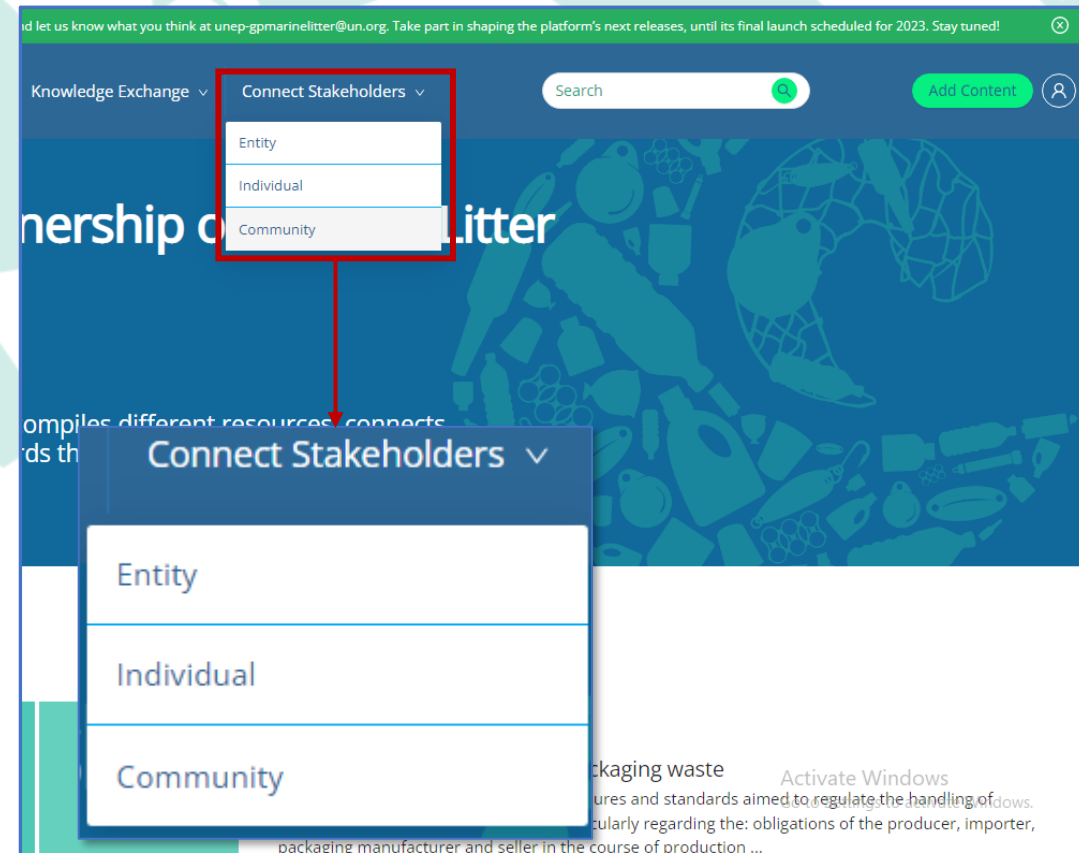


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4. A pop up will appear. Sign up with your preferred method. Your account will be approved within 48 hours. Once your account is approved, you can access all the digital platform's functionalities.
5. To access the communities, click on [Connect Stakeholders](#) on the navigation bar. A drop-down menu appears. Select [Community](#).

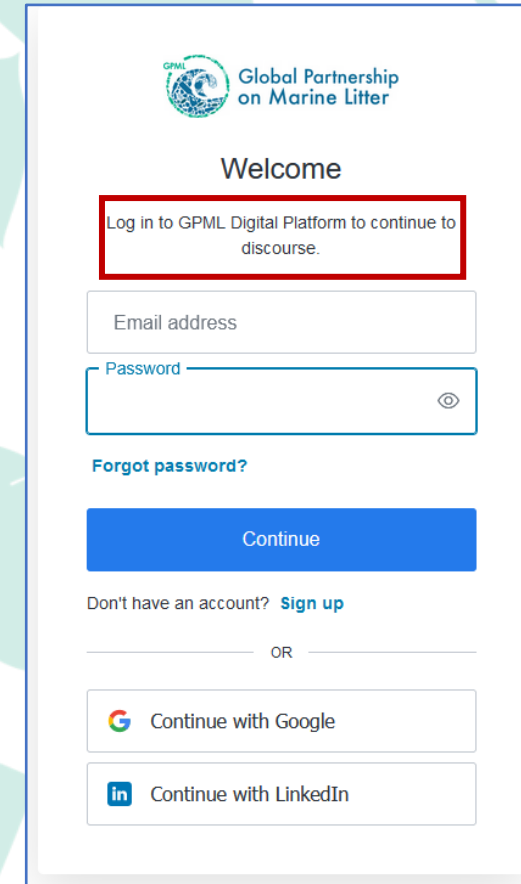
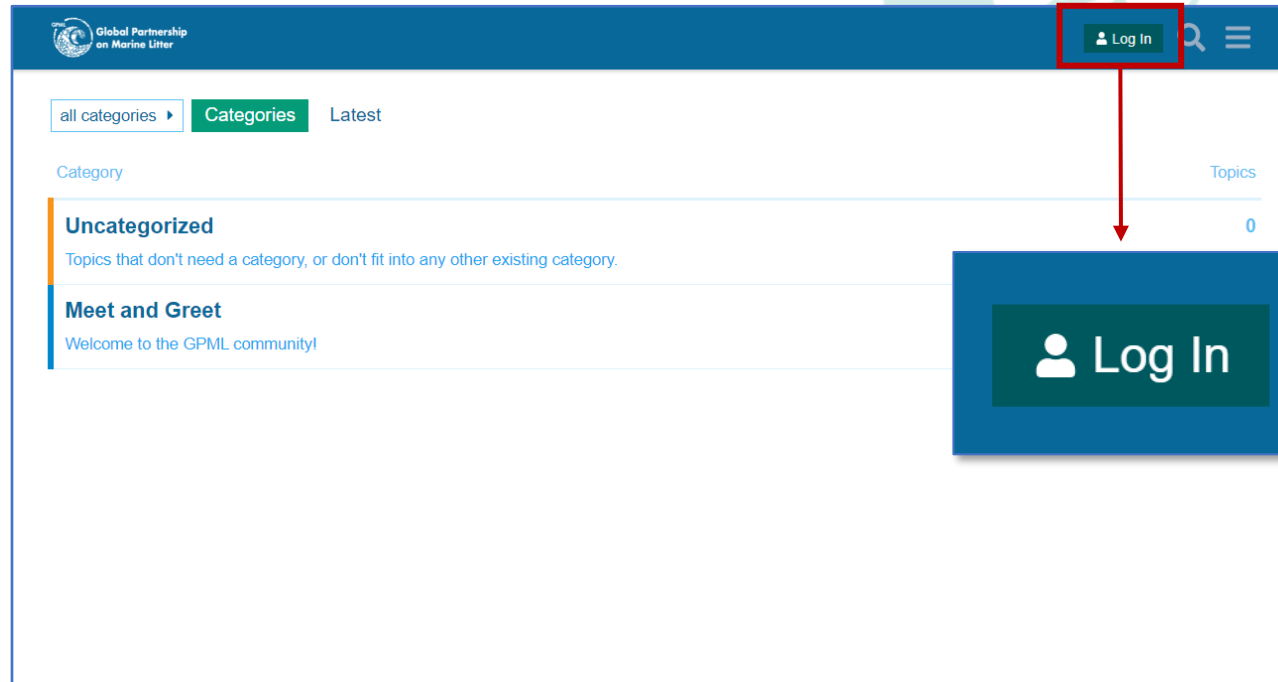

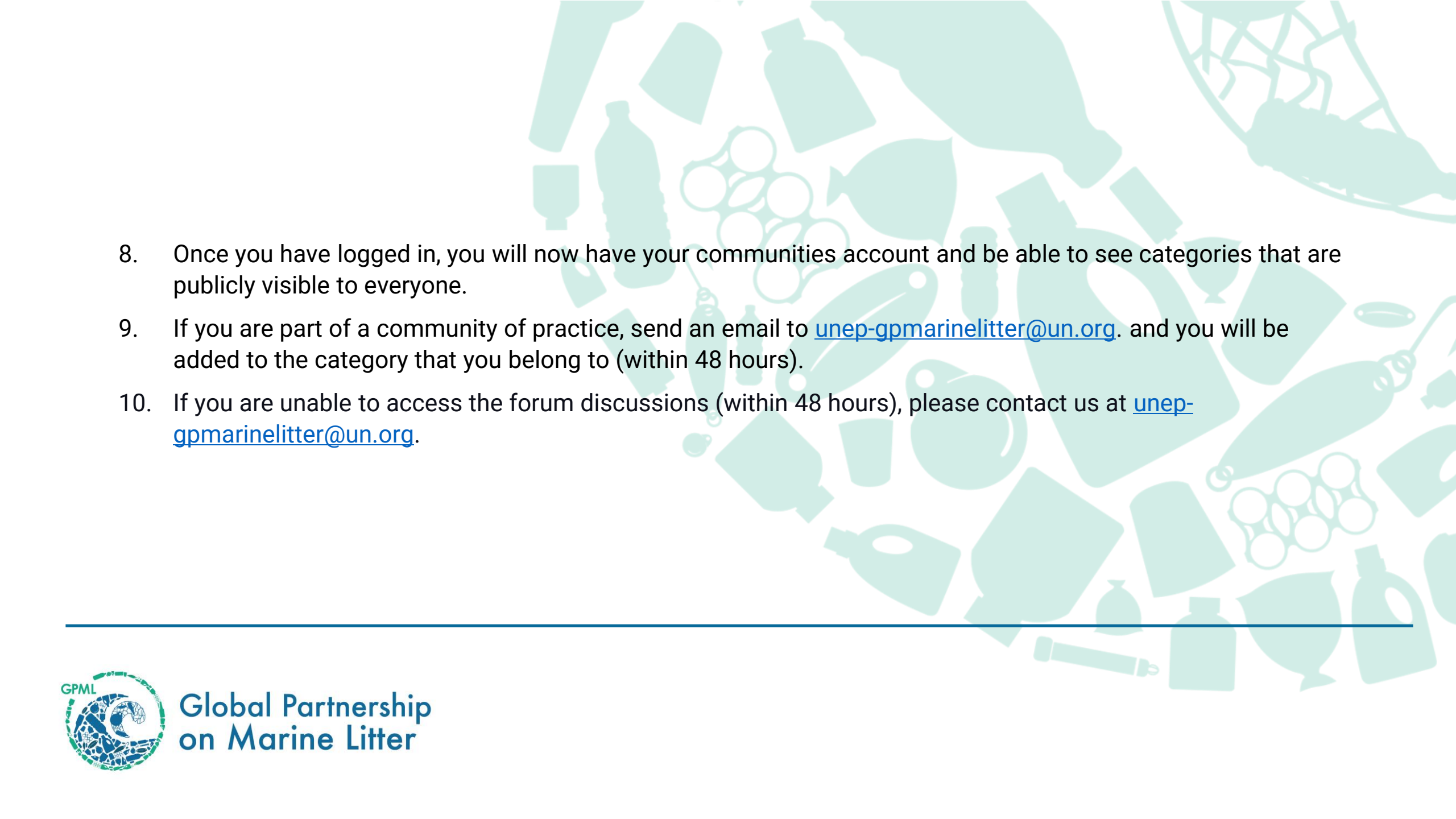


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- You will be directed to the communities url: <https://communities.gpmarinelitter.org/>.
